Albert M Pike, 82, a resident of Canton for many years and town assessor almost thirty years, died about 10:40 Friday morning, Nov. 17 at the Potsdam hospital, where he had been a patient for two days.

On October 5, 1892, Mr. Pike married Alice Grace Knox, daughter of Harvey W. S. and Horal Knox of Colton at the Knox home in a ceremony performed by the late Dr. John Stebbins Lee of St. Lawrence university. The couple lived at the old Pike farm until 1919. In 1919, the couple moved to the village of Canton, 13 Crescent st.

Mr. and Mrs. Pike celebrated their 56th wedding anniversary in 1949. She died at 78 years of age at the A. Barton Hepburn hospital, Ogdensburg, Feb. 14. 1949. She had been active in the Order of the Eastern Star, had received a golden sheaf certificate in the Silas Wright Grange, and was a member of the First Universalist church.

Surviving are one son, Harvey K. Pike, Pierrepont road, manager of the St. Lawrence National Farm Loan association of Canton and three daughters, Mrs. Murray (Audrey) Smith, Canton; Mrs. Noel (Inez) Grant, Brooklyn and Mrs. Theodore P. (Doris) Gibson, Pike road. There are also seven grandchildren.
