MISS VELMA PIMM

Victor, Oct. 12.—The death of Miss Velma Pimm, a resident of the town, occurred at the Memorial Hospital, Canandaigua, where she was sent ten days ago. She was taken ill in Rochester, where she was employed, some weeks ago, and was later taken to the home of her aunt, Mrs. Etta Hill Sizer, at Fishers in the western part of this town. Miss Pimm was only 20 years of age and was the daughter of the late Sidney and Mrs. Ella Hill Pimm. She leaves one brother, Earl Pimm, of Fishers; her grandfather, Sidney Pimm, of this village, and aunts and uncles. The body has been taken to the home of the aunt in Fishers, from which place the funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon, Rev. Edwin P. Wood, of the local Universalist church, will officiate, and interment will be made in the Boughton Hill cemetery.
