JESSIE MOSES PLAISTED DEAD

Much Beloved Greenwood Lady, A Former Whitesville Girl Relieved  
From Long Suffering—Associate Matron, Greenwood Chapter, O E S

The many Whitesville friends of Mrs. Jessie Moses Plaisted of Greenwood learned with deep regret of her passing away in the St. James Hospital at Hornell, Tuesday, March 25 after a six weeks' illness of toxic poisoning.

Mrs. Plaisted had been in poor health for the past three years. Last week Thursday she was taken to the hospital at Hornell and Friday underwent a very serious operation, but rallied nicely and was considered doing as well as possible until a short time before her death.

Deceased was the daughter of Jessie Ward and John Moses and was born in Whitesville April 5, 1867, thus being in her 52d year of her life. On April 5, 1887 she was united in marriage to Edward W. Plaisted of Greenwood, who together with one son Guy E., and a daughter Marjorie; also three sisters, Mrs. Sarah Coykendall of Whitesville, Mrs. Mary Halsey, Whitesville, and Mrs. Elizabeth King of Oakland, Va.; and one brother Cyrus [G.] Moses of Whitesville are left to mourn the loss of wife, mother and sister whose gentle ways endeared her to family and numerous acquaintances and friends.

Mrs. Plaisted was Associate Matron of the Greenwood Chapter No. 574, O.E.S., which order will attend the funeral in a body.

The last sad rites for the departed will be held from the late home in Greenwood to-morrow (Friday). Burial in Greenwood Cemetery, Rev. [C. L.] Paddock of Whitesville [Universalist] officiating.
