MRS. JULIA POOL, 73, DIES SUDDENLY AT HER HOME (Special to The Standard)

NATURAL BRIDGE, Dec. 26—Mrs. Julia Pool, 73, wife of Jay Pool, died at 12:30 A.M. today of cerebral hemorrhage. She was about the house as usual yesterday and enjoyed Christmas dinner with her daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Couchene who lived with her and her husband.

At 11:40 P.M. she called her daughter who found the mother standing beside the bed and complaining of severe pains in the back. Mrs. Myra Weatherhead, a daughter, and Mr. and Mrs. Stanford Lewis, neighbors, were summoned and a doctor was called. Mrs. Pool died before the doctor could arrive. She was unconscious 20 minutes after she called her daughter.

She was born in Diana in November 1850, a daughter of David and Lucretia Palmer and was married [on] December 31, 1867. She was afflicted with deafness 40 years ago and communication with her was always written. Her mind was alert and she took a great interest in current topics.

She was a member of the Universalist Church and of Grange No. 497. Her husband suffered a shock [stroke] some time ago and is an invalid. Besides the daughters and husband there survives a grandson, Leon Weatherhead.

The funeral will be held Saturday at 2 P.M. at the house, Dr. G. D. [George Delbert] Walker [Universalist] of Carthage officiating. The grange burial service will be held. Interment will be made at Hillside cemetery.
