Mrs. Minnie Poole died Friday morning, Nov. 25, at her residence in Henderson Harbor. The funeral was held Sunday afternoon at 1:30 from her home, Rev. Gustave Ulrich, pastor of the First Universalist church, officiating. Interment was made in Evergreen cemetery.

Mrs. Poole was born on August 5, 1862, in Henderson Harbor, the daughter of Augusta [Augustus] and Clarissa Dye Bassett, and had always lived there. She married Horace Carpenter about 1881, who died about two years later. About 35 years ago she married Charles Poole of Henderson, who died March 28, 1917. Since then she had been living with her brother, James Bassett of Henderson Harbor.

She is survived by one brother, James Bassett; two cousins, LaMort Bassett of Henderson Harbor, and Nona Bassett of Ypsilanti, Mich. Mrs. Poole was well known and highly respected in Henderson Harbor.

For many years she was associated with her brother in a boarding house at the Harbor.
