DR. L. G. PROBASCOS

After a long illness, Dr. L. G. Probasco of Whitesville passed to the Other Side on December 24. He served the entire section about Whitesville in every type of weather and was a distinguished physician. He was born in Flemington, N.J., in 1872. He was a graduate of Alfred University, Baltimore Medical School and took graduate work in the New York City Medical School. Thirty-six years ago, he located in Whitesville. He was president of the First National Bank in the village, president of the Water Company, a director of the New York & Penn. railroad, health officer and a trustee of the Universalist church. He was married in 1904 to Miss May Richmond, who with a son [George W. Probasco] and a daughter [Retta Gene Gath] survive him. The memorial service was conducted by the Rev. A. E. Allison in the Probasco home on December 27.
