MRS. IDA W. JACKSON

Mrs. Ida Wagner Jackson, 72, widow of Dr. John C. Jackson, died at 5 P.M. Saturday at her home, corner of Division and Center streets, Fort Plain. She had been ill for several months, following a stroke.

Born December 2, 1869, in the Town of Canajoharie, a daughter of Harvey and Margaret Garlock Wagner, she had resided during her lifetime in this vicinity.

Dr. Jackson died in 1927. Her brother, Dr. Charles P. Wagner, of St. Johnsville, died within a few days of Dr. Jackson.

Mrs. Jackson was a descendant of pioneer families in this section and was a member of the Fort Plain Chapter, DAR and the Fort Plain Universalist church. She graduated from the Clinton Liberal Institute of Fort Plain [a Universalist school which burned down in 1900].

The survivors include two sons, Dr. John W. Jackson of Scarsdale and Harvey W. Jackson of Utica; two granddaughters and one grandson; three sisters, Mrs. Charles C. Washburn and Miss Ola Wagner of Fort Plain, and Mrs. Waldo T. Hunter of Brooklyn.

The funeral was held on Monday at 2:30 from her home. Rev. William Haney, pastor of the Fort Plain Universalist church, officiated. Burial was in the Fort Plain Cemetery.
