At a meeting of a number of the adult male inhabitants of the town of Auburn held at the Western Exchange on the twenty fourth day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty three pursuant to public notice and according to the Statute incorporating Religious Societies in such case made and provided[,] George Standart was duly chosen Chairman of said meeting and Daniel Baldwin Secretary, Thereupon it was resolved and agreed that the said Society shall hereafter be known and distinguished by the name of the "First Universalist Society in Auburn[.]"—The following persons were then and there duly elected Trustees of said Society to wit, Allen Worden[,] Ezekiel Williams, William H. Coffin, Josiah Barber, Stephen Lombard Junior, Ethan A. Warden, Jarvis Swift, Salmon Tyler and John G. Paul, and that the said Trustees and their successors are ever hereafter to be known and called by the name of the Trustees of "The First Universalist Society in Auburn[;]" that immediately after said Election the said Trustees were divided by lot into three classes as follows: Allen Worden[,] Ezekiel Williams & William H. Coffin are to compose the first class—John G. Paul, Josiah Barber and Salmon Tyler the second class—Ethan A. Warden[,] Jarvis Swift and Stephen Lombard Junior are to compose the third class.
