## Elbridge, Onondaga Co. NY (Jordan)

A meeting of inhabitants of the towns of Elbridge[,] Camillus[,] Van Buren[,] Brutus [and] Cato composed of believers in the Universal Salvation of all Mankind which meeting was held agreeable to legal & previous notice at the west School House in the Village of Jordan on the 7 day of June 1831 when Arial N. Brown was chosen President & Ashley Clark Clerk of said meeting[.] [A]fter the object of the meeting were [sic] stated it was resolved that we form ourselves into a Society by the name & title of the first Universalist Society in the town of Elbridge[.] The following persons were chosen Trustees viz—Arial N. Brown[,] Squire M. Brown[,] Charles Lord[,] Anthony Johnson[,] Henry Meech[,] David [Ward?], John Lylle, Hosea Buck and Ashley Clark to superintend the temporal concerns of said Society a Constitution was reported by the Trustees and adopted by the meeting[.]
