## Elbridge, Onondaga Co. NY (Jordan)

We the undersigned three members of the Religious Society heareafter [sic] mentioned do hereby cirtify [sic] that on the 16 day of June 1860 the male persons of full age belonging to said Religious Society in which divine worship is celebrated according to the rights [sic] of the Universalist Church and not already incorporated met in Clinton Hall the place of public worship heretofore occupied by said Religious Society in the village of Jordan in the said county of Onondaga for the purpose of incorporating themselves and did then and there elect by plurality of voices Dr. George Thomas, R. H. Shaff [and] Thomas Harrington as Trustees of said Religious Society and the said persons did then & there also determine by like plurality of voices that the said Trustees and their successors should forever after be called and known by the name or title of the "First Universalist Society of Jordan, Onondaga County" in the State of New York. Witness our hands & seals this the 16 day of June 1860.
