

Fleming, Cayuga County NY

At a Meeting of Universalists held agreeable to public notice given according to law in that case made and provided, for the purpose of organizing religious societies, at the School House near the dwelling house of Caleb Wadams Jr. in the town of Fleming in the county of Cayuga and State of New York on the 22nd day of December in the year of our Lord 1823[.]

Whereupon, it was voted that Newton Marsh serve as Moderator. Voted that Ephraim Hammond serve as Secretary. Voted that this Society be called the first Universalist Society of the town of Fleming. Voted that John G. Paul[,], Alvin Simond and Sylvester Riley serve as Trustees to said Society. All of which we do certify to be true, as witness our hands and seals this 22nd Decem. 1823[.]
