We the undersigned two of the members of the Religious Society hereinafter mentioned, do hereby certify that on the twentieth day of March instant the male persons of full age belonging to a religious society in which Divine worship is celebrated according to the rites of the Universalist Church and not already incorporated, met at the School House in the town of Hammond in said county for the purpose of incorporating themselves, and did then and there elect by plurality of voices David W. Baldwin, Jonas Moyer, Henry Zoller, Peter G. W. Daggart [and] Josiah Zoller as Trustees, as aforesaid, and the said persons did then and there also determine by like plurality of voices, that the said Trustees and their successors should forever hereafter be called and known by the name or title of the Trustees of the First Universalist Society of Hammond and Rossie. Witness our hands and seals this the twentieth day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty six.
