We the undersigned do hereby certify to all it may concern that the first Religious Society of Unaversalists [sic] in Lisle County of Broome and State of New York did on the 4th day of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen assemble together at their place of public worship pursuant to legal notice before given in order to elect Trustees of their Society agreeable [to] law in that case made and provided—And furthermore that when assembled as aforesaid they did proceed to elect three trustees viz. John Hollenback 1th [sic] James Graham 2^d and Thomas Richards 3^d class who are to be known by the name of the Trustees of the First Religious Society of Unaversalists [sic] in Lisle—In witness whereof we the returning officers hereunto set our hands and seals the day and year above written[.]
