Whereas notice has been duly given according to law for the formation of a Society to be stiled [sic] the first Universalist Society in the town of Madrid, and whereas a number of the members did meet pursuant to such notice at the house of Lorenzo Lockwood in the village of Columbia on the 30th day of March inst. for the purpose of organizing such meeting, which being called to order Joseph Freeman Esq. was appointed chairman of said meeting. Whereupon Alfred Goss and H. B. Richardson were appointed by a majority of the members present to preside and to receive the votes of the Electors for trustees of the said Society. We do therefore hereby certify that the following persons were elected, viz. Hiram Winslow, William McGowan and Ezekiel Abernathy were duly elected as such trustees.
