Whereas by a certificate duly executed dated December 10th 1829 and recorded in the office of the Register of the city and county of New York in Liber 1 of Certificates of Religious Incorporations page 169 the Third Universalist Society in the City of New York Religious Incorporations were duly incorporated and were to be hereafter known and designated by the said name and title and whereas from ___? the accounts and inventory of the estate and revenues of the said Incorporations have been ___? to be made and ___? in pursuance of the statute in such case made and provided whereby the said incorporation have [sic] ceased to be a body corporate and whereas it is desirable in compliance with and pursuant to Section 16th of the Act of the Legislature of the State of New York entitled "an act to provide for the incorporation of Religious Societies" passed 5th April 1813 to incorporate the said The Third Universalist Society in the city of New York Now therefore be it known that we Edwin Knapp and Nathaniel S. Rose two of The Third Universalist Society in the City of New York do hereby certify that at a meeting of the male persons of full age who have stately worshipped with said society and have been considered as belonging convened on the twentieth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifty two at their church edifice situate corner of Bleecker and Downing Streets in said city where such persons stately attend for divine worship in pursuance of public notice given according to law for the purpose of electing trustees to take the charge of the estate and property of the said society and to transact all business relative to the temporalities thereof we the said Edwin Knapp and Nathaniel S. Rose being such Elders as aforesaid were nominated by the majority of the members there present to preside at such election And we do further certify that at such election the following named persons were duly elected by plurality of voices to serve as trustees for the said society—to wit Warren Marriot[,] William Tucker[,] Thomas E. Allen[,] Silas B. Furbush[,] David C. Archer[,] James Vreeland Moore[,] Thomas Williams[,] Frederick C. Havemeyer and Peter [VanNess?] and we do further certify that the said society is now called and known by the name of The Third Universalist Society in the City of New York In witness whereof we have unto set our hands and seals this twentieth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifty two[.]
