Chapin; 6. Hymn; 7. Installing Prayer, by Rev. C.[Cyrus] H. Fay; 8. Address to the Pastor and Fellowship, by Rev. D.[Day] K. Lee; 9. Address to the Society, by Rev. T. B. Thayer; 10. Hymn; 11. Benediction, by the Pastor. The meeting was largely attended, and hundreds went away unable to gain admittance to the Church. The Sermon, by Rev. Mr. Chapin, was marked with his usual ability, and his hearers were entranced by his eloquent and spirited delivery.
