VALUE OF A CAMERA IN TRAVEL

Ex-President A. B. Hervey of St. Lawrence University, Monday night, at Avena Hall, Ninth Street and Sixth Avenue, Brooklyn, exploited the utility of adding the skill of an amateur photographer to the observation of a scholar in a plan of leisurely travel. Sixty fine photographs thrown on a screen in the course of a lecture upon "Modern Athens" were largely Dr. Hervey's own work. The lecture was given for the benefit of the Prospect Heights Universalist Church, and was a chapter from a prolonged stay on the Greek peninsula last Spring.
