The Executive Board of the Convention recently voted that aid to churches as a function of the New York State Convention of Universalists be abolished.

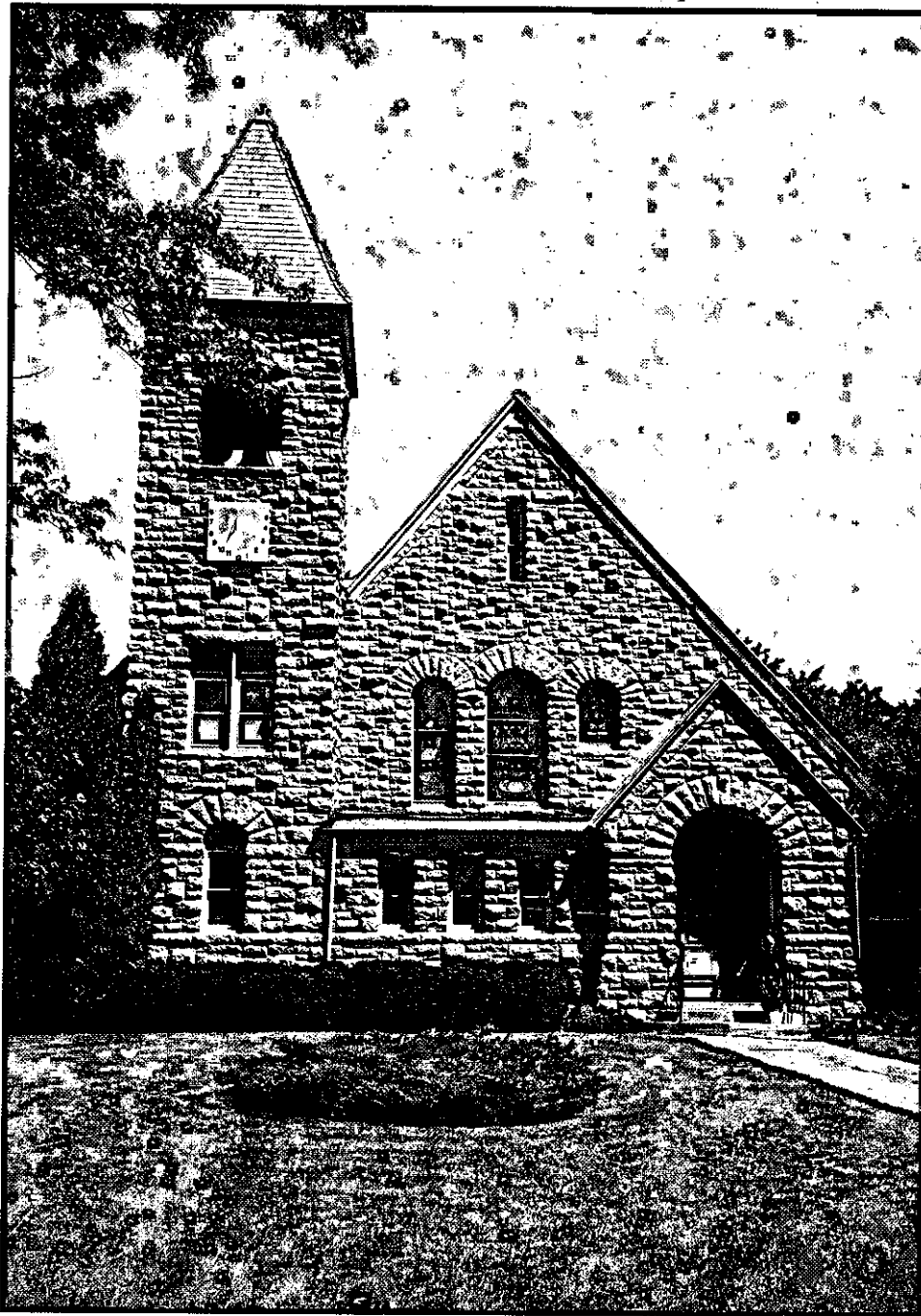
In determining the method of implementing this policy the Board determined that the Canton Church should continue to receive aid with the annual ten per-cent reduction now in effect.
