My dear Mr. Randall;

I have completed the sale of the Guba Church and herewith enclose a check of the Treasurer of the Methodist Society which purchased the property. The amount of the check is \$994.00 which is the balance of the purchase price, \$1000.00 less \$6.00, the cost of the abstract, which I asked Mr. Renwick, representing the purchaser to order as he is on the ground, and to deduct the cost of it from the purchase price which he has done.
