7 of Chapter 33, of the Laws of
1907: that at said Meeting there

First Universalist Society of the Town
of Danversville be and they are hereby
authorized to convey the premises
owned and occupied by said Society
and described in a certain Warranty Deed
dated April 8, 1853, recorded in the Clerk's
office of Sturben County, by April 20,
1853 at 10 o'clock AM in Liber 67 of
Deeds at Page 14, to the New York State
Convention of Universalists,

That said resolution was freely
and fully considered and discussed
and upon a vote being taken, seven
(7) voting members voted in favor and
three (3) voting members voted against
said Resolution: That the Chairman
thereupon declared the Resolution
duly carried: that the Resolution
incorporated in the Deed of conveyance
to said New York State Convention, ^{of Universalists}
is a ^{correct} copy of the above resolution.
