Early History of McLean
(excerpt)

The First Universalist Society of Groton was organized at McLean April 21, 1832, with about thirty members. The church ediface [edifice] was erected about 1843 and cost, including furnishings, about \$3,000. The first minister was Walter Bullard; the present minister, Herbert H. Graves. The present membership of the church is twenty-seven.
