This Indenture, Made this Twenty fifth day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty seventy two Between

Alexander Martin, of the first part, and Mrs. A. Martin Nelson Lloyd and others Trustees of the First Universalist Society of Linn or North Bloomfield, and their successors in office of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollars, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof he hereby confessed and acknowledged, has he bargained, sold, remised and QUIT-CLAIMED, and by these Presents do bargain, sell, remise and Quit-claim unto the said party of the second part,

and to his heirs and assigns forever, ALL that parcel of land in the highway at a point eight rods east of the north-west corner of the lot standing on old Brick Meeting House lot: thence running south on the East line of said lot to the south East corner of the same: thence East in line with south line of said lot seven rods: thence North, parallel with first line to the highway: thence North seven rods to the place of beginning containing about one fourth of an acre, and the land aforesaid is given for the purpose of having a church erected thereon, and when it ceases to be occupied for the aforesaid purpose to revert to my estate, and the parties of the second part covenant and agree to keep said premises enclosed with a good and substantial fence.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim and demand whatsoever of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, of, in and to the above bargained premises, with the said hereditaments and appurtenances, to Have and to Hold the said described premises to the said party of the second part, and their successors in office heirs and assigns, to the sole and only proper benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
