Mr. Simmons comes well recommended and qualified to take charge of this church, which has been without a pastor since the death of Rev. A. L. Partridge, in September, 1907. He is the son of the late Rev. J. S. Simmons, of Woodstock, Vermont. He graduated from the Canton Theological Seminary in June, 1908.
