DR. ANDREW JACKSON CANFIELD

WEST HARWICH, Mass., Aug. 25.—The Rev. Dr. Andrew Jackson Canfield, a Universalist clergyman, who had several prominent charges in Brooklyn, died here yesterday, after a two weeks' illness, from spinal meningitis. Dr. Canfield was 69 years old. For many years he was one of the leading clergymen of Brooklyn, where he was first pastor of All Souls' Church [First Universalist Church of Williamsburgh], and later built up the Church of Our Father [First Universalist Society of Brooklyn], at Grand Avenue and Lefferts Place. He had been connected with All Souls' Church of Worcester, Mass., for the last five years.
