DR. LORENZO D. CASE

The death of the Rev. Lorenzo D. Case, D.D., occurred in his home at Clark Lake, Michigan, on March 1. He died in his eightieth year, after a year's serious illness. He was born in Watertown and following his graduation from the high school, he entered St. Lawrence University. He was graduated from the College of Letters and Science in 1895 and in the following year from the Theological School. He began his ministry in the pastorate of the Universalist church at Rome. His other pastorates were in Albany; Chicago, Ill.; Lowell, Mass.; Old town, Maine and East Liberty, Michigan. He was prominent in Masonic circles and in his later years his interest was particularly in rural churches. He is survived by his wife.

The Rev. Argyl Houser conducted the memorial service in the Universalist church at East Liberty on March 4.
