NOTED CLERGYMAN DEAD

The Rev. Dr. George L. Demorest [sic], D.D., Lived in Brooklyn Many Years

Rev. George L. Demerest [Demarest], D.D., one of the best known clergymen in the Universalist denomination, died at Manchester, N.H., on Tuesday, and the body was buried this morning in Greenwood Cemetery, the Rev. L. Ward Brigham, pastor of All Souls Church, officiating. Dr. Demerest lived in Brooklyn for many years. He was the first Sunday school superintendent of All Souls Church. He was born ninety-three years ago. As a young man he worked for Harper Brothers, and then entered the Universalist Church, and has been one of the most effective and best loved ministers in the denomination. From 1877 until recently [four days before his death] he was the general secretary of the Universalist Church. He is survived by a son and daughter.
