Rev. Marguerite H. J. Hess of Albion passed away at the home of her sister Mrs. Frank C. [Marie] Northway in Clarendon, Sunday, February 13, 1944, at 4:00 p.m. after a brief illness. Her only sister survives her, also several nieces [Elsie M. Northway and Ruth M. Northway], a nephew [Joseph H. Northway] and four grandnieces.

Miss Hess was an ordained minister of the Universalist faith. During her earlier years she was pastor of the Universalist Church at Stockton, Illinois, while studying at Chicago University. Later she supplied various churches in Western New York.

Later she entered the State Civil Service and was employed for eighteen years as the New York State Transit Commission in New York City until her retirement, after which she made her home in Albion.

Miss Hess was the elder daughter of the late Joseph F. [and Johanna] Hess, Temperance Evangelist of former years and well known throughout the United States and Canada.
