The Rev. Robert Killam, Former Utica Pastor, Dies

The Rev. Robert Killam, D.D., 56, of Cleveland, Ohio, former pastor of the Church of the Reconciliation [Universalist] here, died Sept. 1 I Mary Hitchcock Memorial Hospital, Hanover, N.H.

Dr. Killam was pastor at the Church of the Reconciliation from 1935 to 1947 when he became pastor of the First Unitarian Church in Cleveland. He was serving in Cleveland at the time of his death.

Born in Brooklyn, he attended public schools in New York City and Dickinson College. He received his bachelor of divinity degree from the Theological School of St. Lawrence University and his doctorate from St. Lawrence University.

Dr. Killam also had served pastorates in Springfield, Mass., and Rutland and Barnard, Vt.

He leaves his wife, Mrs. Frances Heaton Killam; a son, Stephen Robert; a daughter, Miss Jean Anne, both at home, and his mother, Mrs. Lafayette Killam of Brooklyn.

A memorial service was held Sept. 3 in Barnard. Another memorial service will be held in Cleveland.
