Once Pastor Here, Dies in the West
Well-Known Universalist and Former College Head Succumbs in Los Angeles

Los Angeles, April 5—The Rev. Dr. C. Elwood Nash, noted Universalist figure and former pastor of the Church of Our Father, in Brooklyn, died yesterday at his home here. He was 77.

Dr. Nash, who was for nine years president of Lombard College, Galesburg, Ill., was born in Allamuchy, N.J.

After leaving Lombard College he was general superintendent of the Universalist Convention, governing body of the Universalist Church, with headquarters in Boston.

He also had served as pastor of churches in Akron, Ohio; Stamford, Conn., and Newtonville, Mass., before coming here, 25 years ago. He served in Brooklyn for several years.
