Rev. OREN [ORRIN] ROBERTS, died at Montrose, N. Y., Jan. 22, 1882, in the 73d year of his age. He began preaching over fifty years ago. He was ordained in 1833, at Lakeville, N.Y., where he was pastor for seventeen years. Afterwards he removed to Illinois, and followed the work of his calling in different parts of that State. He was always loyal to his faith and church, ever anxious to bring men to see the truth as the gospel sets it forth. Both as a preacher and a writer he did good service for the cause which he loved. He had ability, energy, and consecration, whereby he was able to do good work in the years of his active ministry. By reason of bodily disability he had been without a pastorate and unable to preach regularly for nearly twenty years, but he continued to use his pen in the advocacy of the faith he cherished. He was an able preacher, a forcible writer, a faithful, true-hearted Christian.
