Macedon, Dec. 26.—The death of Adelbert Adams occurred at the farm home southeast of this village on Thursday morning. Mr. Adams was a life long resident of this section and was born on October 7, 1856, a son of the late George and Cynthia Parker Adams. He was educated in the Macedon schools. Mr. Adams was twice married. His first wife, Miss Mary Southworth, passed away in 1886 and later he was united in marriage with Miss Jessie McLouth. He was a very successful farmer, a Republican, a member of Macedon Masonic lodge and a member of the Farmington Grange. He leaves his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Beverly Crowell of Manchester; one son, Vernon Adams, who resides at the family home; and four grandchildren. The funeral service was held from the home Saturday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Rev. A. E. Allison of Nunda, a former pastor, and Rev. George J. Porter of the Macedon Universalist church, officiating, and the local lodge of Masons had charge of the burial service.
