ONCE RESIDENT OF FORT PLAIN

Albert H. Adams Dies in Buffalo of Injuries Resulting From Fall.

Buffalo, May 14.—Both the G. A. R. and representatives of the Masonic lodge here attended the funeral of Albert H. Adams, native of Fort Plain, who died at his home here, 506 Porter avenue, last Friday night, from the effects of a fall sustained more than a week ago. The Rev. Bruce Swift of Grace Messiah Universalist church officiated at the funeral service, which was held at the home yesterday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock. Lake Erie commandery, Knights Templar, had charge of the service at the grave in Forest Lawn cemetery.

Mr. Adams came to Buffalo from Fort Plain while a youth and was employed by the Niagara Elevator company. He remained with this firm until he entered the insurance business. He was married twice, in 1870 to Thalia M. Davis, who died in 1880, and in 1915 to Mrs. Caroline Hatch, who survives him. Two daughters, Maude W. Adams of Buffalo and Mrs. Theodore N. Dillaway of Philadelphia, Pa., also survive. Mr. Adams had been an insurance agent in Buffalo for the past 25 years.
