H. Warren Adams Dies; Was Former Frewsburg Man

Frewsburg—The death of H. Warren Adams, 41, formerly of Frewsburg, occurred Sunday night in the Warsaw Community Hospital, Warsaw, N.Y. He was stricken with a heart attack Dec. 23 at his home in Perry, N.Y. He was popularly known as "Doc." Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Emmaline Safford Adams of Perry; his mother, Mrs. Nina Davis Adams and a sister, Mrs. Virginia Adams Hultberg, both of Frewsburg. He was born in the Town of Carroll Aug. 15, 1903. His marriage took place March 21, 1936. His father, the late Hiram Warren Adams, died in 1931 at Frewsburg.

Mr. Adams was a prominent citizen of Perry. He was in the employ of the S. W. Hart Insurance Agency for the past four years. For the past three years, he had served as village treasurer, succeeding John D. Rudgers, resigned. He was a member of the Perry Rotary Club, Constellation Lodge, F. & A.M., Perry Club and the Universalist Church.

For a short time, he was employed by the Lake Shore Seed Company, covering most of the eastern part of the United States. He then went with the Borden Company, being stationed in Frewsburg, Arcade and Union City before being sent to Perry.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon.
