Daniel P. Albert of Clarendon Dead

BERGEN, Nov. 18—Postmaster [Benjamin] Walker received a telegram about noon yesterday from his wife, announcing the death of her father, Daniel P. Albert, which took place Wednesday evening at 7:45 o'clock at his home in the town of Clarendon, 2½ miles northwest of North Bergen, the cause being heart disease. Mr. Albert, whose age was 64, had been an invalid a year, but was confined to his bed only a short time. During his last hours he suffered intensely. He leaves a wife [Amelia Glidden Albert], one daughter, Mrs. B. N. [Harriet/Hattie A.] Walker of this village, and three sons, William and Bert of Clarendon and Daniel B. of Williamsville. This is the first death in the family. The funeral will be held Sunday in the Clarendon Universalist church, and the burial will take place at Holley.
