## Frank Allen Dies at 84

PERCH RIVER—Frank J. Allen, 84, retired farmer, died unexpectedly about 3 Saturday afternoon at his home on the Allen road, near Perch River. He had been resting in his room and his sister found him dead on his bed.

The funeral will be Tuesday at 2 p.m., at the family home.

Rev. Adolf W. Weidanz, pastor of the Dexter Universalist church, will officiate. Burial will be in Perch River cemetery.

Surviving are two sisters, Miss Mae Allen, who lived with him at the family homestead; Mrs. Irene Lehr, widow of Allen J. Lehr, Watertown, and a nephew John W. Lehr, Watertown.

Mr. Allen was born May 2, 1882, a son of James W. and Clara Baker Allen, at the Allen homestead. He spent his entire life there, operating the farm until his retirement.
