Miss Lydia Allen died at her home near the village on Saturday afternoon in her seventy-ninth year. Miss Allen was the last member of the household of three sisters and two brothers, who remained on the old Allen homestead living a happy, quiet life with each other and their books. Their nephew, Arthur Allen, who has lived with and cared for them for many years, remains at the old home. Miss Allen leaves two sisters, Mrs. Willis Perkins and Mrs. Miranda Brown, and a brother, Mr. Henry Allen. Rev. S. [Samuel] R. Ward [Universalist] officiated at the services held at the house at two o'clock on Tuesday, and she was laid to rest in the family cemetery on a knoll chosen by the revolutionary ancestor of the family.
