Mrs. Minnie Sawdy Allen died at her home here on May 15. She was born at Pooville April 29, 1848, a daughter of Harvey and Celinda Hubbard Sawdy. She was educated in the district school and in Owego. On June 22, 1870, she married I. Seabury Allen of Brookfield, who died May 30, 1918. With the exception of one year spent with Mr. Allen's people, all her married life had been spent in this place and in the house in which she died. She was a member of the Universalist Church and a zealous worker in the Church and its societies when health permitted. The love and esteem in which she was held was manifest in the many beautiful flowers. Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. James [May] Baldwin of Utica and Miss Ora Allen of this place, who had tenderly cared for her mother many years; also two grandchildren, Janice and Allen Baldwin of Utica. The funeral was held May 18 at her late home, Rev. William Lamphere of Madison officiating. Burial was made in the Hubbardsville cemetery. The bearers were Clarence Chapple, Harold Henderson, Albert Ogden and George Swayze.
