MRS. NETTIE HUNT [SIC] DIED MONDAY Life Long Resident of Potsdam Passed Away at Local Hospital

Mrs. Nettie Hunt Allen, a lifelong resident of Potsdam, died Monday, January 31, at the Potsdam Hospital. Mrs. Allen was taken to the hospital with a severe case of tonsillitis on Thursday of last week. Complications developed which caused her death.

Mrs. Allen was born on a farm on the west side of the Racquette River between Potsdam and Hannawa Falls on January 7, 1862, the daughter of Edward S. and Triphence Kent Hunt. She was married to De Elbert [Delbert] Jason Allen on March 23, 1887. Their early married life was spent on the farm, later moving to Potsdam and in 1916 bought the home on Bay street where she has since resided. Mr. Allen died Feb. 4, 1931.

Both Mr. and Mrs. Allen had a host of friends both old and young and her memory will last for many years.

She was a member of the [former] Universalist Church, the Rebecca Lodge and the Pomona Grange. In the Rebecca Lodge she was a Past Noble Grand and in the Grange was a lecturer.

Mrs. Allen is survived by a niece, Mrs. Mable Rogers of Adams, N.Y.

Funeral services will be held at the home Wednesday afternoon at three o'clock. Rev. Hugh S. Tigner of the Canton Universalist church, assisted by Rev. Monmouth H. Horton of the Baptist church of Potsdam, officiating. The body will be placed in the vault awaiting burial in Bayside in the spring.
