### Death of An Old Resident

Samuel G. Allen, one of Hudson's oldest and most highly respected citizens, died at his residence on Green street this morning, in his 84th year. Mr. Allen was a gardener for many years at the Church property opposite Catskill, and to him was due to a great extent the beauty of the grounds and surroundings. He is survived by David Allen, James w. Allen, and Mrs. Lyman T. Hoffman, of this city; Samuel Allen, of Chicago; William Allen, of Philadelphia, and Mrs. Lizzie Pettit, of Stottville. He retired several years ago from active work, and spent much of his time about his home.
