WELLINGTON ALLEN

Herkimer—Wellington Allen, 76, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Ceylon [Minnie] Walby, (169?) Henry Street, last night. He had been ill the past year due to a stroke and suffered a second one Wednesday.

Mr. Allen was born in the Town of Warren, Mar. 9, 1855, and lived in Richfield Springs and vicinity until 1921 when he came to Herkimer following the death of his wife to live with his daughter. He was a farmer and married Miss Josephine McCreery [McRorie] Feb. 20, 1873.

Besides the daughter with whom he lived he is survived by a (grand?) son, Arnold W. Hadcock of Herkimer; two brothers, Washington and Charles Allen, and a sister, Mrs. Clarence Bresee, all of Richfield Springs.

The funeral will be Tuesday at the 2 o'clock at Mrs. Walby's home, the Rev. W. H. Skeels officiating. Burial will be in Springfield Center. Mr. Allen attended the Universalist Church.
