Mrs. Teresa K. Allison, wife of Rev. A.E. Allison, former pastor of the Nunda Universalist church, died suddenly Monday, of apoplexy at the family home in Canton, Mass. The remains were brought to Nunda Thursday and taken to the home of Mr. and Mrs. W.R. Marsh, where funeral services will be held Friday at 2:30 p.m. and interment made in Oakwood Cemetery. Rev. Clara E. Morgan of Cohocton, a close friend of Mrs. Allison, will conduct the funeral.

Teresa K. Knappenberg was born in Nunda sixty years ago last January, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. William S. Knappenberg. Her first husband, the late Dr. William Baylor, died sixteen years ago, and nine years ago she married Rev. Allison, then pastor of the Nunda Universalist church, who survives with his son Paul, who graduates this year from Harvard School of Business Administration.

Mrs. Allison was one of the founders of the Nunda Woman's Relief Corps and a charter member and the first Matron of the Eastern Star chapter. Possessed of a brilliant mind and engaging personality, Mrs. Allison during her residence here took a prominent part in social and fraternal circles and was admired and esteemed by a wide circle of friends.
