Mrs. Ella W. Andrus, wife of B. Britt Andrus of Clarendon, died at her home at 9 o'clock Sunday night, September 15, 1929, following a three months' illness.

Mrs. Andrus was born at Clarendon on May 7, 1855, a daughter of the late David and Mary Ann Stuckey Wetherbee, and she had always resided there. She was married to Mr. Andrus on December 11, 1879.

Besides her husband she leaves two daughters, Mrs. Earl Smith of No. 263 Sherwood Avenue, Rochester, and Mrs. Herbert Salisbury of Brockport; four grandchildren, Harlan and Paul Smith of Rochester and Neil and Ella Salisbury of Brockport; a sister, Mrs. John Morton of Clarendon, and a niece, Mrs. John Preston of No. 2 Prospect Avenue, Batavia. Mrs. Andrus was a member of the Clarendon Universalist church, the Ladies' Aid Society of the church, Clarendon W.C.T.U. and the Clarendon Grange.

Funeral services were held at her late home at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. L. H. [Lewis] Robinson, pastor of the Clarendon Universalist church and the Albion Pullman Memorial Church, officiating. Interment took place in Hillside cemetery at Holley.
