Mrs. Cynthia Angell passed away at her Grove street, Morris, home Tuesday morning at 9:15 after a long illness due to pneumonia and complications.

Funeral services, conducted by Rev. F. [Frederick] G Leonard of the Universalist church, were held at Sloan's funeral home Thursday afternoon at 2. Interment was in the family plot in the new part of Hillington cemetery.

Cynthia Angell, one of the five children of Thompson and Mary (Burgess) Bemiss, was born in Edmeston, October 12, 1857. The family came to Morris many years ago and purchased a farm in this township, where she spent nearly all her life. She was twice married. Her first husband was Thomas Smith of Morris and her second husband, Jonathan Angell of Upper Dimmock Hollow.

Mrs. Angell had resided alone for many years just outside the village where her neighborly acts and high ideals of living won her many friends, all of whom will cherish her memory. Failing health caused her to close her home a year ago and come to this village, where she had been tenderly cared for since that time by her niece, Mrs. Lee Colburn.
