GEORGE S. ARMSTRONG

George S. Armstrong died suddenly Wednesday at Cedar Rapids, Ia., where he went on a visit. Funeral services will be held at 8 o'clock to-night at his late home, 398 East Eighteenth street, this borough, the Rev. Dr. Bartlett, of All Souls Universalist Church, officiating. Burial in Greenwood Cemetery to-morrow. Mr. Armstrong was born in Manhattan, had lived in Brooklyn for thirty-five years and was a member of Crescent Lodge, F. and A. M., in Manhattan, and the Crescent Commandery. He is survived by a widow, Lucy Armstrong; one son, George S., Jr., and one daughter, Mrs. F. Krunbeck. Mr. Armstrong had long been a member of All Souls.
