BOWEN AROLD PASSES AWAY
Highly Regarded Resident of Dolgeville Is Claimed by Death

DOLGEVILLE—Bowen Arnold, 71, died Sunday morning at 12:15 at his home on Spencer street. The deceased was born on March 10, 1861 in Fairfield, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Arnold. Until 13 years ago, when he moved here with his family, he lived in Herkimer. In 1895 he was married to Jennie Nichols, who survives. Besides his wife he leaves seven sons, Ernest, Glen, Olin, Otto, Bowen, Arthur and Kenneth; two daughters, Mrs. J.W. Carr of New Jersey and Miss Ethel Arnold of this village, also one brother, Henry Arnold of Little Falls.

The funeral will be held this afternoon at 2 at the Universalist church, Rev. C. [Clinton] A. Moulton officiating. Interment will be made in Church street cemetery in Little Falls.
