HIS LONG LIFE IS AT AN END  
Death of James A. Arnold at the Age of 90 Years.

Little Falls, June 14—Another of the old and highly esteemed residents of Little Falls passed away at 6 o'clock last evening, when James A. Arnold died at his home on Prospect street, at the advanced age of 90 years. He was well known, not only in that city, but throughout the county. His eyesight had been failing for some time and during the past two years he had been practically blind and helpless.

James A. Arnold was born in the town of Fairfield and was the youngest of thirteen children. In 1853 he married Lucinda O. Burrell of Columbia and went to farming in the town of Richfield. Eight years later he returned to Fairfield, where he remained until 1875, when he came to Little Falls, where he has since resided. He is survived by one son, J. Colfax Arnold, a letter carrier in this city. The funeral will be held from the late home Thursday at 2 p.m. It is expected the Rev. E. F. Pembroke of Bangor, Me., a former pastor of the Universalist church in this city, will officiate.
