DEAD AT THE AGE OF EIGHTY-ONE YEARS
Lucinda, Wife of James A. Arnold, Had Been Ailing for Some Time

Little Falls, Jan. 16—At her home, 71 Prospect street, this morning, occurred the death of Lucinda, wife of James A. Arnold, aged 81 years. A general breaking down of her system was the cause of death. Her maiden name was Lucinda D. Burrill and in 1853 she was married to J. [James] Arnold in the town of Columbia. She came to this city with her family in 1878. Besides her husband she is survived by one son, [J.] Colfax, and one sister, Mrs. Sanford Getman of East Schuyler. The funeral will be held Friday from her late home, the Rev. H. E. Benton [Universalist] officiating.
