Miss Sue Arnold Dies, Dolgeville Musician

DOLGEVILLE—Miss Sue C. Arnold, 63, of 18 N. Helmer Ave., former music teacher, died Saturday in Little Falls Hospital, where she was admitted that afternoon.

Miss Arnold was born Aug. 9, 1891, in Fairfield, a daughter of George and Minnie Drake Arnold. An accomplished musician, she studied piano and violin at the Utica School of Music and taught here many years.

She was a granddaughter of Col. William Feeler, for whom the local DAR chapter is named. She was an active member and at the time of her death served as chaplain. She was a member of the Universalist Church.

Miss Arnold leaves one sister, Mrs. Leah Crossman, Dolgeville, and several cousins.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow from her home, with interment in Dolgeville Cemetery. The Rev. Gale Bascombe, Universalist pastor, will officiate.
