While he has not been in robust health for some time past, still he has been able to be about the house and this morning as usual was around and sat outside on the porch. A little before noon he felt a weak spell coming on and went inside and laid down on the couch, and before medical attendance could be secured he had passed away. Mr. Aubin has been a resident of this city a number of years and by his honest and upright manner of dealing and pleasant disposition has made many warm friends who will deeply deplore his demise. He is survived by his wife [Ada], two sons, Carl of Syracuse and Sidney of this city, and one daughter, Mrs. Charles M. Austin of this city, all of whom may feel assured of the sympathy of their many friends in their affliction. The funeral arrangements are as yet incomplete.
