Alvah Avery

Dolgeville—Alvah Avery, Town of Salisbury, died Jan. 6, 1952, in Pinecrest Sanatorium. He had been a patient there for about four weeks.

Mr. Avery was born in Stratford on July 22, 1866, a son of Anson and Sally Dalrymple Avery. On July 4, 1885, he married Hattie DeLunn. She died about seven years ago [in 1944].

A resident of the Town of Salisbury for about 52 years, Mr. Avery was a farmer most of his life.

He leaves a son, Earl, Little Falls RD 1; a daughter, Mrs. Grace Sebros, Utica; several grandchildren, nieces, nephews and cousins.

The funeral will be at 2 tomorrow at the Jacobsen Funeral Home with the Rev. Gale Bascomb, pastor of the Universalist Church, officiating. The body will be placed in the Dolgeville vault for burial in the Spring in the Dolgeville Rural Cemetery.
